Industry Representative – An employee, stakeholder or representative of an organization operating equipment on or connected to the inland or intracoastal waterways of the United States. Coastal or near coastal operators with similar equipment needs may qualify. Operators outside of the United States may also qualify. Examples of the type of organization that will qualify include, but are not limited to, barge transportation firms, fleet operators, shallow-draft terminals, dock owners, public port authorities, inland shipyards, midstream service providers, marine contractors, dredge operators, ferryboat and passenger vessel operators, divers, salvage and response organizations, waterfront scrap facilities and surveyors.

Non-Exhibiting Supplier – An employee, shareholder or representative of any organization that supplies products or services to industry representatives (the buyers). These are attendees who may otherwise benefit from exhibiting but do not do so, nor belong in any of the categories below.

Additional Exhibit Booth Staff – Exhibitors are allowed up to 3 complimentary registrations per 100 sq. ft. of space. Any additional staff may be registered under this category.

Shipper – An employee, shareholder or representative of any organization that uses or has the potential to use inland or intracoastal waterways to ship goods and products.

Media (Editorial Staff) – An employee, shareholder or representative of a company providing either trade, local or national media coverage that is specifically attending for story leads and editorial content. Advertising sales staff and other titles must register as a Non-Exhibiting Supplier.

Government/Port Authorities/Associations – An employee or representative of a partnering federal government organization like the Corps of Engineers, Coast Guard or MarAd; a state or local organization, such as a municipality, public port authority and its commissioners, DOT or a fire and rescue department; and employees of associations involved in advocating for those qualified as industry representatives.

Career Fair Participant (Wed., May 24 Only) – Individuals interested in pursuing a career on the inland and intracoastal waterways with companies and organizations in any of the above categories.
