
Successful Implementation of EPA Tier 4 with SCR Technology on the U.S. Inland Waterways

Successful implementation of EPA Tier 4 marine engines with SCR technology continues on the U.S. Inland Waterways. SCR technology brings immediate advantages and value to inland waterway owners/operators, including significant reduction in fuel consumption and CO2. The supply network on the rivers for urea-based diesel exhaust fluid (DEF) used in engines' selective catalytic reduction systems is expanding with efficient supply chain management from numerous midstreamers. The panel will provide an update from engine original equipment manufacturers (OEMs), DEF suppliers, owners/operators and shipyards on successful implementation of this technology.


